

General Election 2016

Polls Open: 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016. Listed below are the precincts to help assist you in determining your voting location. If you are unsure, you may call City Hall staff to help you determine which precinct you are located in. You may also use the **Polling Place Finder** at the Minnesota Secretary of State website at:

Precinct I Location - City Hall in the Ballroom (2nd Floor)

- Persons living **east** of the railroad tracks and **north** of Lyon Ave to the Goodhue County line.

Precinct II Location - St. Mary's of the Lake Catholic Church (lobby)

- Persons living **east** of the railroad tracks and **south** of Lyon Ave to City Limits

Precinct III Location - City Hall in the Ballroom (2nd Floor)

- Persons living **west** of the railroad tracks and **south** of the Goodhue County line

Precinct IV Location - Valley View Assembly of God Church (lobby)

- Persons living in the Goodhue County portion of Lake City

Election Reminder

Before you can vote, you must register to vote with the address where you live. In Minnesota, you may register up to 20 days before an Election Day or on Election Day at your polling place.

Visit www.sos.state.mn.us to register online, or stop in City Hall to complete a **Voter Registration Application**.

Your registration remains current until you move, change your name, or do not vote for four consecutive years.

If you chose to register on Election Day, you **MUST** bring proper ID with you. One of the following ID's with your current name and address in the precinct are acceptable:

- Valid Minnesota Driver's license, Minnesota learner's permit or Minnesota ID card
- The yellow receipt for a Minnesota driver's license, learner's permit or ID card
- Tribal ID card with name, current address, signature & picture issued by the tribal government

If the above ID **does not** show your current name and/or address in the precinct please contact City Hall for additional requirements to register or visit www.sos.state.mn.us
