The purpose of the meeting is to go over the research, findings, and recommendations for the City's first historic district along South Oak Street in Lake City, Minnesota.

The City has hired a preservation consultant, Greg Gaut, to evaluate the District and write the nomination materials required for the historic designation process. This report includes a total of 39 properties to be included in the District. Of these 39 properties, the majority of them have retained significant historical integrity and contribute to the character of the District.

We welcome you, as a property owner within the District, to come and learn about the designation process, visit with the Commission and City Staff, and ask questions. There will be a brief presentation of about ½ hour at the beginning of the meeting and the remaining ½ hour will be for discussion.
