

NORTH GARDEN STREET PROJECT UPDATE #1

Week of April 20:

- The Contractor started to lay out and install the temporary water system for the southern segment of Phase 1. They will fill pipe with water and let it sit over the weekend for testing next week.
 - The temporary water system will be a 2-inch pipe and service branches will be a smaller diameter hose connection to the house. PLEASE DO NOT touch or attempt to move the temporary water lines. The Contractor will berm the water lines at each driveway so residents can access their driveway. It's OK to drive over the bermed water line. Also, DO NOT mow over the temporary water line.
- The Contractor also installed sediment protection devices in the impacted storm drains.

Week of April 27:

- The Contractor will test the temporary water system. After the tests pass, they will start making temporary connections to homes and install new water valves in the street to help control the water system operations.
- The Contractor plans to start pavement removals with a focus of the road segment between Doughty Street to a little north of Jewell Street.

Project Notes:

- **Update on Garbage Pick-Up:** Lake City Recycling will be installing address stickers on both garbage cans at each house; this way everyone gets their own garbage can back. They will plan on picking up garbage on North Garden Street as long as it's passable. If the garbage company can't access a block, it will be the homeowner's responsibility to take their cans to the closest side road. Both Lake City Recycling and each homeowner should have enough advance notice that the garbage truck will not be able to pick-up in front of certain homes.
- **Update on Bussing:** The current bus schedule has pick-up and drop-off on the 100, 400, 600, and 800 blocks of North Garden Street. The plan for the construction project is to move all pick-up and drop-off to North Oak Street at the same blocks when school is in session. **The change over to North Oak Street will begin on APRIL 27, 2026.**

This change is a new development resulting from continued planning between the City and bus company. *Please share this with neighbors to help spread the message.* We anticipate that the bus company will also be communicating with residents who have school-aged children that ride the bus.
