

**CHAPTER 113: TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, TV CABLE AND ELECTRIC
LIGHT AND ELECTRIC POWER COMPANIES**

§ 113.01 PERMIT REQUIRED.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, company or corporation to erect, set or place any telegraph, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power wire or wires over, under, upon or along any street, alley or public grounds within the city without first having obtained a permit therefore. (1981 Code, §410.01) Penalty, see § 10.99

§ 113.02 APPLICATION.

Any person or persons, company or corporation desiring to erect any telegraph, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power pole or poles or lay, place or string any telegraph, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power wire or wires within the city shall make written application to the Public Works Director for a permit to do so, showing by the application upon what street or streets the person, company or corporation desires permission to erect the poles or place the wires, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power poles or placing the wires as to the height of the poles, depth in the ground, conduits, if placed beneath the surface, their position and the manner of fastening the wire or wires to the poles. (1981 Code, § 410.03)

§ 113.03 SUPERVISION.

In case permission is granted by the Public Works Director to any such person, company or corporation making application therefore, all poles shall be erected and all wires laid or placed under the direct supervision and control of the Public Works Director or his or her representative. (1981 Code, § 410.05)

§ 113.04 REQUIREMENTS.

All poles erected by any person, company or corporation shall not come within four inches of any wire, unless such wire is attached to the pole by a proper glass or porcelain insulator and the same to be done at the expense of the person, company or corporation erecting the poles. (1981 Code, § 410.07)

§ 113.05 RESETTING OF POLES.

Whenever any street on which any telegraph, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power pole shall have been set shall be graded or paved, the telegraph, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power company, corporation or person owning or operating the same shall, at its own cost, reset the poles so as to conform to the street as reconstructed. (1981 Code, § 410.09)

§ 113.06 REMOVAL AND REESTABLISHED POLES.

Any telegraph, telephone, TV cable, electric light or electric power wire or wires not established, placed or operated in accordance with the provisions of this section shall be removed or reestablished in accordance with this section, at the expense of the owner thereof. (1981 Code, § 410.11)

§ 113.07 VIOLATION.

The Council may at any time revoke any permit for a violation of this chapter and compel the removal of any and all poles and wires so permitted to be set, strung or placed from any or all streets, alleys and public grounds or public places or property where the same may be set, placed or strung or may cause any pole, poles or wires to be changed from one place to another. (1981 Code, § 410.13)
