SCHEDULE I. HANDICAP PARKING.

(A) Parallel parking space located on the west side of South Garden Street, 365 feet south of the intersection of West Marion Street.

(B) Parallel parking space located on the south side of West Doughty Street, 25 feet west of the intersection of North 6th Street.

(C) Parallel parking space located on the south side of West Doughty Street, 160 feet west of the intersection of North Prairie Street.

(D) Angle parking space located on south side of Center Street, 53 feet east from the curb on Washington Street to the center of the parking space.

(E) Angle parking space located on the north side of Center Street, 35 feet west from the curb on Washington Street to the center of the parking space.

(F) Parallel parking space located on the south side of Lyon Avenue, 69 feet east of Lakeshore Drive.

(G) Angle parking space located on the south side of Center Street, 33 feet west from the curb on High Street to the center of the parking space. (Res. passed - -; Am. Res. passed - -)

SCHEDULE II. FIVE-MINUTE PARKING.

Five-minute parking is permitted on the south side of Chestnut Street beginning at a location 75 feet west of Harbor Drive and ending at a location 250 west of Harbor Drive. (Res. passed - -)

SCHEDULE III. TEN-MINUTE PARKING.

Ten-minute parking is permitted in the following locations:

(A) Angle parking space located on High Street, 106 feet south from the intersection of Lyon Avenue to the center of the parking space.

(B) Angle parking space located on High Street, 119 feet south from the intersection of Lyon Avenue to the center of the parking space.

(C) Angle parking space located on High Street, 146 feet south from the intersection of Lyon Avenue to the center of the parking space.

(D) Angle parking space located on High Street, 159 feet south from the intersection of Lyon Avenue to the center of the parking space.

SCHEDULE IV. TWO-HOUR PARKING - 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. - MONDAY TO SATURDAY.

Two-hour parking is permitted in the following locations from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday.

- (A) Marion Street from Lakeshore Drive to Franklin Street.
- (B) Center Street from High Street to Washington Street.
- (C) Lyon Avenue from High Street to Franklin Street.
- (D) High Street along the easterly side thereof from Center Street to Lyon Avenue.
- (E) Lakeshore Drive from Chestnut Street southerly to the termination of Washington Street.

SCHEDULE V. FOUR-HOUR PARKING.

Four-hour parking is permitted in a city parking lot located on the west side of Lakeshore Drive and north of Marion Street. (Res. passed - -)

SCHEDULE VI. SEVENTY-TWO HOUR PARKING.

Parking will be permitted for 72 hours at the following locations:

- (A) On all streets and highways located in city.
- (B) City parking lot located on the east side of High Street and north side of Marion Street.
- (C) Leased city parking lot located on easterly side in the 200 block of South Washington Street.

SCHEDULE VII. NO PARKING ANYTIME.

There is no parking anytime at the following locations.

- (A) On the east and west sides of Park Street from Chestnut Street to a location 168 feet southeast of Franklin Street.
- (B) On the north side of Chestnut Street beginning at Harbor Drive and ending 250 feet west of Harbor Drive.
- (C) On the south side of Chestnut Street at a location beginning 271 feet east of Park Street and ending 379 feet east of Park Street.

(D) On the north and south sides of Lake Street beginning on the southerly end of Harbor Drive and ending on the westerly end of Harbor Drive and from Lake Street and Harbor Drive westerly to the termination of Harbor Drive.

(E) Woodburn Street from 7th Street, west to the termination of Woodburn Street.

(F) South 10th Street across from J & B Pallet Factory, 1000 Block. (Res. passed - -; Am. Res. passed - -) Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE VIII. SCHOOL ZONE.

There is no parking on school days, except school buses, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., at the following locations.

(A) South side of West Marion Street between South Garden Street and South Prairie Street.

(B) West side of South Garden Street between West Marion Street and West Irving Street. (Res. passed - -)

(C) Transit bus parking only Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. West side of Cross Street and north of West Lakewood Avenue adjacent to Bluffview Elementary School. (Am. Res. - -) Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE IX. NO PARKING - 3:00 A.M. TO 6:00 A.M.

There is no parking from 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. in the following locations:

(A) High Street from Chestnut Street to Marion Street.

(B) Lakeshore Drive from Chestnut Street to Marion Street.

(C) Washington Street from Chestnut Street to the termination of Washington Street.

(D) Franklin Street from Chestnut Street to Marion Street:

(1) From April 15 through October 31, Franklin Street from Chestnut Street to Marion Street;

(2) From November 1 through March 31, Franklin Street from Chestnut Street to Lyon Avenue.

(E) Chestnut Street from High Street to Park Street.

(F) Lyon Avenue from High Street to Franklin Street.

(G) Center Street from High Street to Franklin Street.

(H) Marion Street from High Street to Franklin Street. (Res. passed - -) Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE X. TWENTY-MINUTE TRUCK LOADING.

Twenty-minute truck loading is permitted from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, in the following locations:

(A) On the east side of Lakeshore Drive beginning 46 feet north of Lyon Avenue and ending 110 feet north of Lyon Avenue.

(B) On the east side of Lakeshore Drive beginning 24 feet north of Center Street and ending 66 feet north of Center Street. (Res. passed - -)

SCHEDULE XI. NO PARKING 11:00 PM. TO 5:00 A.M.

There is no parking between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. at the following locations:

(A) Parking lot located at the pier turn around.

(B) Parking lot located at Roschen Park. (Res. passed - -) Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE XII. RESIDENTIAL PARKING ONLY.

Residential parking only is permitted in the following locations:

(A) East side of 10th Street between Marion Street and Dwelle Street.

(B) 7th Street from Walnut Street to Monroe Street.

(C) Walnut Street from 7th Street to 8th Street.

(D) Doughty Street from 6th Street to 7th Street.

(E) Woodburn Street from 6th Street to 7th Street.

(F) Jewell Avenue from 6th Street, westerly to the termination of Jewell Avenue.

(G) Jefferson Street from 6th Street to 7th Street.

(H) Madison Street from 6th Street to 7th Street.

(I) West side of Oak Street from Dakota Street to Wisconsin Street. (Res. passed - -)

Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE XIII. POST OFFICE PARKING.

Parking is prohibited on the east side of High Street beginning 121 feet north of Center Street and ending 248 feet north of Center Street. (Res. passed - -) Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE XIV. NO TRUCK PARKING.

Truck parking is prohibited in the following locations:

- (A) Lakeshore Drive between Marion Street and Chestnut Street.
- (B) Washington Street between Marion Street and Chestnut Street.
- (C) High Street between Marion Street and Lyon Avenue. (D) Marion Street between Lakeshore Drive and Washington Street.
- (D) Center Street between High Street and Washington Street.
- (E) Lyon Avenue between High Street and Washington Street. (Res. passed - -) Penalty, see § 10.99

SCHEDULE XV. WINTER PARKING.

(A) *Applications.* The owner, driver, operator or person in charge of any motor vehicle within the city limits shall conform to and observe the regulations set forth in this schedule.

(B) *Definitions.* For the purpose of this schedule, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

MOTOR VEHICLES. Any self-propelled device in, upon, or by which any person may be transported or drawn upon any public streets.

PARK, PARKED or PARKING. Stopping, leaving or allowing any motor vehicle, snowmobile or trailer to stand upon the public street.

PUBLIC STREET. The entire width between boundary lines of any way or place within the city limits, when any part thereof is open to public use for vehicular traffic. This includes public ways commonly referred to as alleys, avenues or boulevards.

SNOWMOBILE. A self-propelled vehicle designed for travel on snow or ice steered by skis or runners.

TRAILER. Any vehicle designed for carrying property or passengers on its own structure that can be pulled by a motor vehicle.

(C) *Winter parking restrictions.*

(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave a motor vehicle, snowmobile or trailer on any public street, except on those streets set forth below, when continuous or intermittent snow, ice or similar precipitation has accumulated to a depth of four inches or more. It shall remain unlawful to park on the public street until all snow, ice or similar precipitation has been plowed or removed from the full width of the public street. The following public streets in the downtown business district are excluded from the provisions of this section:

- (a) High Street, from Chestnut Street to Marion Street;
- (b) Lakeshore Drive, from Chestnut Street to Marion Street;
- (c) Washington Street, from Chestnut Street to the lake front;
- (d) Franklin Street, from Marion Street to Chestnut Street;
- (e) Chestnut Street, from High Street to Franklin Street;
- (f) Lyon Avenue, from High Street to Franklin Street;
- (g) Center Street, from Oak Street to Franklin Street; and
- (h) Marion Street, from High Street to Franklin Street.

(2) It shall be the responsibility of the Streets/Parks Superintendent or his or her designee to determine whether or not the snow, ice or other precipitation has accumulated to a depth of four inches or more so as to require the parking restrictions set forth in this schedule to be implemented.

(D) *Prohibition on snow removal from private property.* No person shall remove snow from his or her private property and deposit the same on any public street or parking lot. Any snow so deposited on a public street or parking lot may be removed by the city and the cost of the removal may be charged to the person who deposited the snow or directed that the snow be deposited.

(E) *Posting of signs.* The Streets/Parks Superintendent may erect signs at the municipal boundary lines of each street entering into the city regarding the city's winter parking restrictions. The signs must be uniform in appearance and shall be visible to vehicle operators.

(F) *Authority to place temporary "no parking" signs.* Temporary No Parking signs may be erected by city employees on any street in order to allow for snow removal. No person shall park any motor vehicle, snowmobile or trailer upon the streets where a temporary sign has been erected.

(G) *Penalty.* Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this schedule shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and will receive a fine in the amount set forth in the City's fee schedule.

SCHEDULE XVI. FIFTEEN-MINUTE PARKING - 8:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M.

Fifteen-minute parking is allowed between 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the following locations:

(A) Two marked spaces in the 100 block of East Marion Street, north side (adjacent to South entrance to Kennedy Snyder Drug).

(B) Two marked spaces in the 200 block of S. Lakeshore Drive, east side (adjacent to former Pirates Landing location).

(C) One marked space in 200 block of East Lyon Avenue, north side at corner of North Franklin Street.

(D) One marked space in the 200 block of North Franklin Street.

(E) One marked space in the 100 block of North Franklin Street. (Am. Res. passed - -)
