## Recycling contamination is a concern in our community.

Help us keep our recycling stream clean!

*Adding contaminants to your recyclables can cause the entire load to end up in the landfill.*

**Do not place the following items in your recycling container:**

- No food, liquor or diapers. All containers should be **Empty - Clean - Dry** before recycling.
- No plastic bags of any kind. **DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES!**
- No hangers. **NO HOSES, WIRES, CHAINS or ELECTRONICS.**
- No clothes (or linens). Use donation programs to get rid of these items.



## WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!!!

## PLEASE recycle only the items below:

**PLASTICS:** Recycle plastics #2 & #5. Look on the bottom of containers for a number inside the recycling arrows.

**METAL CANS:** Recycle all food and beverage metal cans — steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.

**GLASS:** Recycle glass bottles and jars.

**CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER and MAGAZINES:**

You can also include newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books & brochures.

**PAPER FOOD CONTAINERS:** Recycle food boxes including: juice boxes, milk cartons, and cereal and pasta boxes.

**PAPER:** Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards & file folders.



## DO NOT RECYCLE:

Plastic Bags, Plastic Straws, Plastic Food Wrappers, Plastic without Numbers, Greasy Food Containers, Windows, Dishes, China, Decanters, Ceramics, Mirrors, Canning Jars, Food or Liquid Waste, Yard Waste, Construction Debris, Scrap Metal, Hazardous Waste, Electronics, Cables or Batteries, Diapers, Tissue, Bio-hazardous Waste, Light Bulbs, Hoses, Toys, Clothes, Shoes, Tools, Styrofoam, To-Go Lids, Holiday Decorations, Hardback Books, Egg Cartons, Ice Cream Cartons (wax coated).
